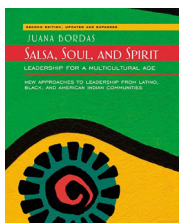


# ANTHC Leadership Book Club

Doctors are eligible to receive CMEs and nurses CE's for participating. Many licensing and professional associations recognize a leadership book club as meeting the professional development credit requirements.

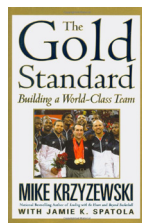
