Leadership Panel Discussion: Oct 3

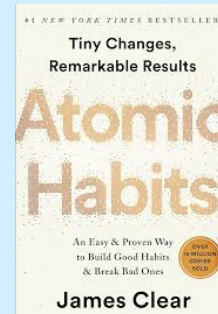
